

Draft Amendment to SB 119

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

3 1 Seasonal Docks. RSA 482-A:3, IV-a(a) is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

4 (a) A legally constructed, grandfathered, permitted, or conforming structure;

5 2 Seasonal Docks. Amend RSA 482-A:3, IV-a(e) to read as follows:

6 (e) No more than 6 feet wide and no more than [40] 50 feet long if the water body is
7 1,000 acres or larger, or no more than [30] 40 feet long if the water body is less than 1,000 acres;

8 3 New Paragraph; Seasonal Boat Lifts. Amend RSA 482-A:3 by inserting after paragraph IV-a
9 the following new paragraph:

10 IV-b. Temporary seasonal boat lifts installed in any lake or pond shall be exempt from the
11 permitting requirements of this section, provided that a notification is sent to the department by the
12 owner of the property that includes the name and address of the property owner, the municipality,
13 the waterbody, and tax map and lot number on which the proposed lift will be located. No more
14 than one boat lift shall be located on any property under this paragraph. To qualify for an
15 exemption under this paragraph, a temporary seasonal boat lift shall:

16 (a) Only be installed adjacent to an existing permitted or grandfathered dock in a
17 legally existing boat slip, such that no additional boat slip or dock is created;

18 (b) Be located at least 20 feet from the abutting property line or imaginary extension of
19 the property line over the water under this section;

20 (c) Be removed during the non-boating season; and

21 (d) Be removed from the lake bed for a minimum of 5 months each year.

22 4 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
